Dear Parents,

Registration for the REACH Before and After School Program for the 2017-18 school year is here. Any family interested in REACH for 2017-18 must fill out an application (even if you are currently enrolled in REACH or on the waiting list). Here are the important details:

April 3, 2017 – REACH applications will become available online at www.southbay.ymca.org, at your child’s school office and at South Bay Family YMCA facilities.

April 10 – April 21, 2017 – REACH applications will be accepted for the enrollment process.

- Applications will only be accepted at the REACH Program.
- Applications must be submitted by an adult.
- Make sure you receive a receipt at the time of application submittal. (Your receipt does not guarantee enrollment)
- During this time, all families wishing to be enrolled must attend a MANDATORY PARENT MEETING in order to complete their registration for 2017-18. Dates/times will be posted at the REACH program.

Starting April 24, 2017- All REACH applications will be reviewed by REACH staff and school personnel. Each REACH program has a maximum number of students that they are able to serve. Student will be enrolled based on the rating system detailed below, up to the capacity for each school’s program. If the program receives more applications than spaces available, first priority for participation will be given to applications with 6 points. Once the REACH program has reached its capacity, students not accepted for participation will be placed on a wait list, in the same order of priority, and will be accepted as space becomes available.

Student participated in the REACH program during the previous school year and met at least 85% attendance.	1 Point
Student was enrolled on the waitlist in the 2016-2017 school year.	1 Point
Student is in transitional kindergarten or new to the district.	1 Point
Student will attend AM program	1 Point
Student will attend PM program.	1 Point
Student has applied for and will attend the full duration of the program, 5 days a week.	2 Points
Student has applied for and will attend half the program time, 5 days a week.	1 Point
Parent will have attended an orientation meeting during the registration period.	1 Point

April 24, 2017-June 7, 2017 - REACH applications received after the end of the initial enrollment period or during the summer will be added to the waiting list. During this time they may only be submitted to the REACH Program at the school.

May 19, 2017 – Enrollment lists will be posted at the REACH Program. Please check the list, as individual families will not be contacted to verify enrollment.

After June 7, 2017 - REACH applications received after the end of the school year will also be added to the waiting list. During this time they may be submitted to the South Bay Family YMCA Childcare Administration Building, 50 4th Ave. Chula Vista, 91910 or scanned/emailed to Iramos@ymca.org.
